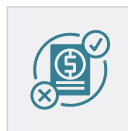
BBA (Finance) Program Introduction

- The programme acts as a 'Stepping Stone' for future CFOs.



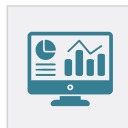

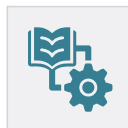

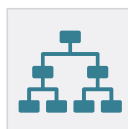
Bloomberg Terminal Access: Hands-on exposure to the terminal enabling students to access real-time financial data and market analytics.

Experiential & Outcome-Based Learning: Real Case studies and Live Industry Projects develop professional competencies.

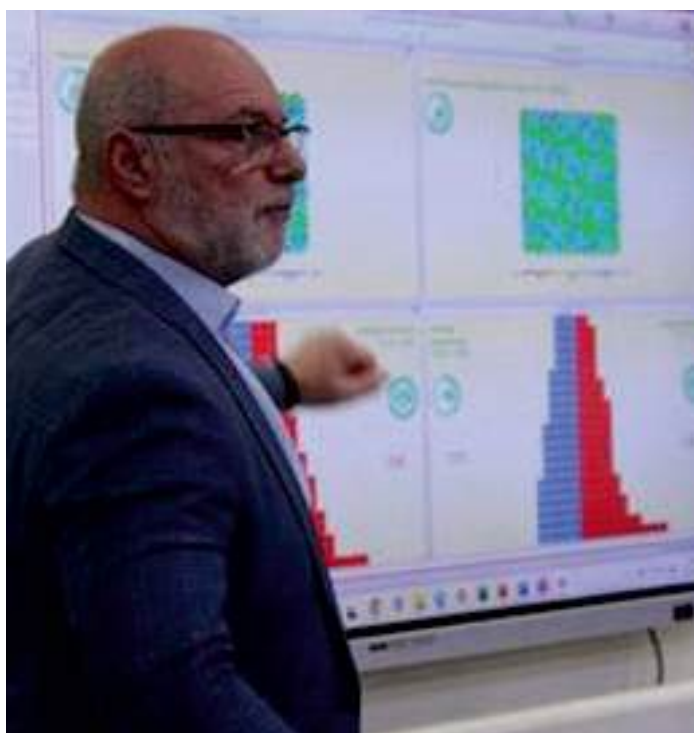

- **Mathematics/Statistics at 10+2 exam is compulsory**
